3Com's **DynamicAccess** software transforms the network interface card into an active network component that can analyze network traffic, support real-time applications, improve network management, and communicate with other system components to tune network performance.

Network interface cards, hubs, and switches are the basic building blocks of workgroups. 3Com's line of **Superstack II** stackable hubs and switches fills all the basic or advanced networking needs for any size of Ethernet or Token Ring workgroups. With 3Com's SuperStack II architecture, you can combine diverse technologies and network services in one stacked system, strengthen it with redundant power and other fault-tolerant features, and manage it all with 3Com's **Transcend Management** software.

The trend toward multimedia and real-time applications demands more bandwidth at the desktop.
